The 5-day event over the last 4 years Folsom Shooting Club's (FSC) Youth Shotgun Clinics conducted at the Sacramento Valley Shooting Center (SVSC) has been very successful. This year the 5-day clinic will be conducted from June 11 through June 15, 2018. The program is intended for those with little or no shotgun shooting experience.

This free program will be available to boys and girls who are at least 12 years of age but not more than 18 years of age. The clinic includes two full days for the NRA Basic Shotgun Course presentation and three half days of shooting at the shotgun range. Shotguns, ammunition, range fees, and the NRA Basic Shotgun Course materials are provided at no cost.

Applications will be made available on or about May 1, 2018 at the (SVSC) Main Range Office during regular business hours and at the Shotgun Range Office but only on Saturdays and Sundays. You may also acquire the information from the club's website at www.sacvalley.org. Only 20 applications will be accepted. Applications must be received on or before June 3, 2018.

NRA Certified Shotgun Instructors will be present for the NRA Basic Shotgun Course and to supervise three morning sessions of shotgun shooting at the Sacramento Valley Shooting Center (SVSC). Additional support will come from members of the Folsom Shotgun League.
