Range #1, Shotgun
Policy and Procedures

In order to promote the safest environment possible for the use and enjoyment of Range 1, Shotgun, the following policy and procedures have been adopted.

The RSO charged with the operation of Range#1 shall strictly follow the policy and procedures set herein and any deviation from the policy and procedures shall have the prior approval of management.

Members and guests using Range #1, during times when the RSO is not present shall strictly follow the policy and procedures set herein.

Days and Hours of Operation

Saturdays and Sundays range #1 is open to members and the general public.

Monday through Friday Range #1 is available to members only. Members must have completed the required orientation.

Hours Open

8:00 am – 4:30 pm

Last shooter is accepted at 3:30 pm

Number of Guests

On member only days, members are limited to four (4) guest per membership. If a member and spouse have two separate memberships, both members may have four (4) unrelated guests. The member assumes responsibility for the conduct of his/her guests and their compliance with all FSC/SVSC rules.

Fees, Waivers and Wrist Bands

The fee for members shall be \$5.00 per round. The fee for the general public shall be \$6.00 per round, plus a \$2.00 daily range usage fee. All shooters must sign the “Range Waver” prior to shooting.

Reservations

Members may not reserve Range #1.

Reservations made by clubs, agencies, non-profit organizations, or vendor/instructors, shall be made 30 days in advance, by using the reservation request form located on the SVSC web page at the calendar link. Clubs, agencies, non-profit organizations, vendor/instructors must ensure all requirements as set forth in the "Rental and Use Agreement" have been met.

FSC/SVSC reserves the right to reassign the client to any Range adequate to the client's intended use.

Cancellation Policy

1. To cancel a reservation, a cancellation request must be sent to calendar@sacvalley.org. SVSC may waive the cancellation requirement if, in Management's sole opinion, the Range (s) are unavailable or unsafe due to weather, maintenance or any other reason beyond the control of SVSC.

Member's only days

1. Before allowing a member to use Range #1, on member only days, staff shall ensure the required orientation has been completed.
2. Shooters and observers must sign the range waver and the shotgun key log before reporting to Range #1.
3. If the Range #1 keys have been checked out and additional members arrive to use Range #1, staff will ensure they also sign the key log. Members using Range #1 must have at least one other person with them for safety.
4. Staff shall ask the member if there is any part of the operation for which they would like a refresher.
5. Staff shall remind member(s) of ammunition requirements.

Orientation Days and Times

The Range #1 (shotgun) orientation will be provided on the first and third Saturday of the month at 7:30 AM. The orientation is required for members to use Range #1 when a RSO is not present.

Clean Up

1. All shooters using Range #1, are responsible for cleaning their shooting area and removal of all debris, trash, hulls, ammunition cases, and shooting supplies at the end of each day.
2. If the range(s) are not clean or in an unsatisfactory condition, SVSC staff must be notified prior to the start of the event, or responsibility is assumed for the condition of the Range.

3. A \$150.00 Range restoration fee shall be charged if in FSC/SVSC sole opinion, the responsible party has failed to remove all debris, hulls, ammunition cases, supplies and/or other materials from the Range(s) rented.
4. It is the sole responsibility of the responsible person, agency, business or non-profit organization to whom the Range(s) have been rented to assure the Range(s) are returned to their original cleanliness.

Range Use and Safety Rules

1. All shooters and observers must sign the range waver when on range property.
2. No loading of shotgun until on the firing position.
3. Shooters shall only load one shell at a time when shooting "singles" and no more than two shells at a time when shooting "doubles".
4. Shooters must ensure shotgun is unloaded and the action is open when moving from station to station.
5. No shooting except at a designated firing position.
6. Driving vehicles on shooting fields is prohibited.
7. At no time will shooters make adjustments or repairs to any of the range machines (Skeet or Trap). Shooters will report issues to range staff.
8. Eye and ear protection is mandatory.
9. Range #1 is a shotgun only range.

Unruly and/or Un-Sportsman Like Behavior.

1. Unruly and/or Un-Sportsman like behavior shall not be tolerated anywhere at SVSC..
2. Unruly and/or Un-Sportsman like behavior shall be reported to the Operations Manager and/or Assistant Operations Manager immediately.
3. Unruly and/or Un-Sportsman like behavior shall be cause for removal from the facility.
4. Unruly and/or Un-Sportsman like behavior includes but is not limited to:
 - The use and/or threats of violence towards anyone.
 - The use of offensive language.
 - The use of loud and/or boisterous language and/or behavior.
 - Failure to obey the commands/instructions from the Range Safety Officer.
 - Violation of any of these policies and procedures.
 - Unsafe firearm handling.
 - Being under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs.

Whenever in the opinion of any FSC/SVSC staff the safety of any other person is being compromised.

Ammunition requirements.

The only ammunition permitted shall be low base shot shells, using 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ or smaller size lead shot. Max load limit not to exceed 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ lead shot, 1 $\frac{1}{8}$ load.

The use of steel shoot is strictly prohibited.
