Range #3-300 Yard Rifle Policy and Procedures

In order to promote the safest environment possible for the use and enjoyment of Range #3, 300 -Yard Rifle, the following policy and procedures have been adopted. The FSC/RSO charged with the operation of Range # 3, shall strictly follow the policy and procedures set herein. Deviation from said policy and procedures shall have the prior approval of management. Members and the public using Range #3, during times when the FSC/RSO is not present shall strictly follow the policy and procedures set herein.

Days and Hours of Operation

Range #3 is open as follows:

1. Range #3 is open to members 7 days a week.
2. Range #3 is closed to the public on Wednesdays and Thursdays.
3. The Range is open from 8 AM to 5:00 PM
4. Last shooter accepted at 4:00 PM, last shot down range at 4:40 PM.

Number of Guests.

On Wednesdays and Thursdays which are members' only days, the number of guest shall be limited to four (4) per membership, in addition to immediate family members.

Fees, Waivers and Wrist Bands.

1. The fee for a voting member shall be \$3.00 for the day. The fee for a non-voting member shall be \$5.00 for the day.
2. Junior members shoot free.
3. The fee for a non-member shall be \$14.00 for the day.
4. The fee for a junior non-member shall be \$7.00 per day.
5. The fee for an active military person shall be \$7.00 per day.
6. All persons using Range #3 and spectators shall sign the SVSC release waiver.
7. All shooters using Range #3 shall be issued a wrist band in a color different from Range #4 and each shooter shall sign the Range #3 sign-in sheet.
8. All non-shooters/spectators shall be issued a white wrist band.

Qualification Requirements for Range #3.

Members and the general public must qualify before using Range #3, by shooting a three (3) to five (5) shot group, on a clean target, at 100 yards. The Shooter shall show the qualification target to range staff.

Recording Qualification.

1. Range staff will record the qualification for members in the Club Century member data base. The general public will be issued a qualification card.
2. The RSO examining the target, must sign the qualification card prior to issuing the card.

Minimum Shooting Distance.

The minimum shooting distance between the firing line and the target, shall be no less than 150 yards.

Target Stands.

1. Shooters using Range #3, shall only use the target stands provided for Range #3.
2. Target stands from the 100 yard rifle range (Range #4) shall not be used.

Safety Procedures for Moving firearms.

1. All firearm shall be cased and uncased at a shooting bench with the muzzle pointing down range. All uncased firearms shall be moved muzzle up, action open and magazine removed until placed on a shooting bench. All rifles must be in a rifle rack, on a shooting bench or in a case. No firearms shall be placed on a table behind the firing line.

Safety Procedures for Cease Fires.

1. Shooters using Range #3, will agree among themselves when to call a cease fire.
2. All firearms must be open and safe, all ammunition and magazines removed.
3. An Empty Chamber Indicator flag shall be inserted into the open chamber.
4. All shooters shall step back and away from the shooting benches and shall not approach the shooting bench during the cease fire.
5. There shall be no handling of firearms during the cease fire.

Ammunition Requirements and Restrictions

1. SVSC maintains that all ammunition must be serviceable and safe. No tracer or incendiary ammunition is permitted. In addition, .416 Barrett and 50 BMG / Euro are banned facility wide.
2. The use of bayonets is strictly prohibited. Bayonets which are folded under the barrel are permitted.

Clean Up.

All shooters using Range #3, are responsible for cleaning their shooting area and picking up or disposing of their spent brass.

Unruly and/or Un-Sportsman Like Behavior.

1. Unruly and/or Un-Sportsman like behavior shall not be tolerated at SVSC.
2. Unruly and/or Un-Sportsman like behavior shall be reported to the Operations Manager and/or Assistant Operations Manager immediately.
3. Unruly and/or Un-Sportsman like behavior shall be cause for removal from the facility.
4. Unruly and/or Un-Sportsman like behavior includes but is not limited to:
 - The use and/or threats of violence towards anyone.
 - The use of offensive language.
 - The use of loud and/or boisterous language and/or behavior.
 - Failure to obey commands/instructions from Range Safety Officers.
 - Violation of range policies and procedures.
 - Unsafe firearm handling.
 - Being under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs.

Whenever in the opinion of any FSC/SVSC range staff the safety of any other person is being compromised.
