

SAFETY IS THE FIRST RULE OF ARCHERY

- **Always keep arrows pointed towards the target when nocking / drawing.**
- **Don't draw at an angle higher than needed to hit the target.**
- **Never draw / shoot if someone is between you and the target, even if not in the direct line of fire.**
- **Wait until everyone on the line has finished shooting before asking to retrieve arrows.**
- **Don't retrieve arrows until the range is declared "clear" and all bows have been secured.**
- **Don't nock an arrow until all shooters have returned to the line.**
- **Don't wander behind the line with arrows nocked.**
- **Do not prolong your shooting if others are waiting to retrieve arrows. Only shoot up to 6 arrows at a time.**
- **Always treat fellow archers with respect.**
- **Keep distractions to a minimum when on the line.**
- **Discard your trash, including damaged arrows, properly. Keep the range clean!**
